### **What is the NLMA Honorary Life Membership**

**Award?** The NLMA Honorary Life Membership Award recognizes persons who, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, has distinguished himself or herself by their achievements in medicine or an allied science, or who has rendered distinguished service to the Newfoundland and Labrador Medical Association (NLMA).

**What are the criteria for the Award?** Criteria for the Award include:

- Over the age of 65 and retired from active practice;
- Significant contributions to the medical profession as defined by at least 10 years of involvement in NLMA activities, which may include Board of Director or committee involvement; and,
- Other considerations including strong liaison with other medical organizations, delivery of quality medical care, political influence, medical research, community service and humanitarian service.
