

## **Dr. Wendy Graham, MD, CCFP**

Dr. Wendy Graham was installed as the 89th President of the Newfoundland and Labrador Medical Association (NLMA) during its annual general meeting on June 7, 2014, at the Health Sciences Centre in St. John's.

Originally from Rose Blanche, Dr. Graham completed her residency training at Memorial University and established her family practice in Port Aux Basques 15 years ago. She practices family medicine and emergency medicine at the Dr. Charles L. LeGrow Health Centre. The Centre provides primary, secondary, and long-term care services through an interdisciplinary team approach to the 9,000 residents living along the Southwest coast.

Dr. Graham also provides care to inpatients in both acute care and long-term care beds at the Centre; makes house calls and visits to personal care homes; and, provides palliative care in the home and in the Centre's palliative care rooms. She joined Memorial University's Discipline of Faculty of Medicine in 2000 and is now an Associate Professor of Family Medicine.

During her inaugural speech, Dr. Graham said that her top priorities as NLMA President will be advancing primary health care renewal in Newfoundland and Labrador, working with the Provincial Government to implement a provincial electronic medical record (EMR) program and negotiating the 2013-2017 MOA for physicians of the province.

Dr. Graham lives in Port aux Basques with her husband Paul and their two children.
