

Dr. Lynn Dwyer, M.D.

Dr. Lynn Dwyer is a family physician in St. John's.

After graduating from Memorial University's Faculty of Medicine in 1986, Dr. Dwyer completed a rotating internship at Misericordia Hospital, University of Alberta. In 1987, she returned to Newfoundland and Labrador, and worked as an emergency room physician in both Gander and St. John's before joining a group family practice in St. John's for 10 years.

For 15 years, Dr. Dwyer worked at the Student Health Clinic at Memorial University. In this role, she treated a culturally diverse student population from over 90 countries, and had the opportunity to contribute to the education of the next generation of physicians as second, third, and fourth year medical students and family medicine residents rotated through the Student Health clinic.

At present, Dr. Dwyer is a family physician at a community-based clinic in St. John's and holds a part-time clinical appointment to the Discipline of Family Medicine at Memorial University's Faculty of Medicine.

Dr. Dwyer is a member of the College of Family Physicians of Canada and a past member of the American College Health Association. She is a member of the Board of the Medical Graduates Society, Memorial University, since 2011 and served as President 2014-2016.

Dr. Dwyer first joined the NLMA Board of Directors in 2014 as a Director At-Large. She also joined the NLMA's Finance Committee that same year and served as its chair from 2015-16. She was elected to the position of President-Elect in 2016 and confirmed as President of the NLMA during the 2017 AGM on June 3.
