

Non-Insured Services

What you need to know...

The Newfoundland and Labrador Medical Care Plan (MCP) provides coverage for the majority of physician services; however, some services are not covered by MCP and you may be required to pay directly.

Speak with your physician for more information about health care services that are not covered by MCP.

Examples of Services Not Covered by MCP:

Medical Services

- Examinations/diagnostic tests requested by employers, insurance companies, government agencies, etc.
- Prescription renewals
- Travel medicine and advice for travelling outside of Canada
- Cosmetic procedures

Completion of Forms and Medical Records

- Medical/Legal reports
- Federal government forms such as:
 - CPP Disability
- Drivers' medical
- Insurance forms, reports and certificates such as:
 - Disability forms
- Work and school related forms such as:
 - Sick notes
 - Employer requested forms (e.g. form physicals)

Administrative Services

- Copying of medical records, reports and letters at the patient's request
- Transfer or summary of medical records at the patient's request
- Missed appointments without sufficient notice
