A full-time Family Medicine clinical position at the level of Clinical Assistant Professor or above, depending on experience, is available. This position is eligible for promotion in accordance with Faculty of Medicine guidelines related to strong performance in education, leadership, research, and clinical excellence. This position is anticipated to commence January 1, 2024, subject to budgetary approval.

This is a clinical position. Clinical responsibilities will include a diversified Family Medicine practice linked to one of the three academic teaching sites in St. John's. The successful candidate will be expected to practice broad scope Family Medicine and teach medical learners in the clinic setting.

Candidates must be certificants of the College of Family Physicians of Canada and eligible for full licensure by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Newfoundland and Labrador. A salaried payment package allows for support to include medical education as part of the practice.
