The NLMA is excited to announce the next phase of the Pathways NL project has begun. Pathways NL is being introduced to the province by the four Family Practice Networks, in collaboration with the NLMA, DHCS, and NLHS, as a solution to enhance the referral process, reduce administrative burden, and improve patient care. Our colleagues in British Columbia, who have used Pathways for 10 years, have indicated it was a game changer for their referral process.

It will be Newfoundland and Labrador's first centralized information sharing resource for family physicians, nurse practitioners, and medical consultants, providing access to current referral information from consultants, clinics, and central intakes including:

- Referral procedures and forms
- Investigations required
- Areas of expertise
- Appointment wait times
- Additional resources for physicians
