Call for Nominations - NLMA Board of Directors

Dear Colleagues,

Five NLMA Board members will complete their terms on the Board following the AGM in June. Nominations are now being accepted for the positions of President-Elect, Rural Director At-Large (2) and Urban Director At Large (2). All eligible members are invited to submit expressions of interest for these positions. The deadline for nominations is **Tuesday, April 22, 2025, at 5:00 p.m.**

Nominations Process:

Eligible candidates must:

- Be a practising NLMA member in good standing with the NLMA and CPSNL;
- Provide a written statement of interest outlining their reasons for joining the Board, which will be shared with voters prior to the election;
- Submit a copy of their detailed CV to the Nominating Committee;
- Provide three (3) references with their contact information; and,
- Commit to annually attend approximately five Board meetings (two in-person and three virtual) as well as ad hoc special meetings as needed, and related committee meetings (by teleconference or in-person) during their term.

Shortlisted nominees shall participate in interviews conducted by the Nominations Committee prior to an election. The Nominating Committee will conduct a thorough screening process and verify in a report to the Board of Directors whether nominees meet the criteria for standing in the election.

- One (1) President-Elect
- Two (2) Rural Directors At-Large
- Two (2) Urban Directors At-Large

At-Large Directors

The election of four At-Large Directors, two rural and two urban, is required to fill the vacancies of members who will complete their terms in June. As per the NLMA By-laws, the term of office for newly elected At-Large Directors is three years. Rather than represent a specific specialty, payment modality or geographic region, At-Large Directors are driven by the interests of the entire NLMA membership. To ensure equal distribution of the six At-Large Directors on the Board, no more than three (3) members from the St. John's metro region serve on the Board at any given time. Past Board members are permitted to submit their names for nomination so long as they have been off the Board for at least one year.

The successful candidate will agree to serve a three-year term on the NLMA Board to fulfill the executive positions of President-Elect, President and Past-President. This position is exempt from geographical considerations. Past and current Board members are permitted to submit their names for nomination.
